How does American Neighborhood Mortgage Acceptance protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does American Neighborhood Mortgage Acceptance collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Apply for a loan or • Open an account or • Pay your bills or • Pay us by check or • Provide account information <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes — information about your creditworthiness • affiliates from using your information to market to you • sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account - unless you tell us otherwise

Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>American Neighborhood Mortgage Acceptance Company LLC may share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>American Neighborhood Mortgage Acceptance Company LLC does not jointly market.</i>
